- EasyShare, WebLogin and Certificate Carrier have been removed

- · Restrict use of devices to within a secure perimeter using ZoneRestrictor
- Backup devices over the Internet using ShieldShare
- Backup is now also available for OS X clients
- Administrators can request user information, such as phone number, and search for it in SafeConsole
- Published applications and documents can be set to automatically launch when device is unlocked

Improvements

- · Windows and OS X clients are now identical visually and feature wise
- · Improved usability of 'set password' screen
- Use of the Actions menu has been minimized and have been replaced with more visible controls
- Settings page has been introduced for password management and feature configurations
- Technical information about the drive is available from the about window
- Log files can be created from the about window to help troubleshooting
- Forgot password screen will appear automatically after a number of failed attempts
- The application window will always be visible
- SafeConsole SSL certificates can be renewed without proactively configuring the new certificate to all devices
